## Publicly Disclosed Information:

### ALLEGATIONS:

County Employee called and left a message indicating that another county employee called them "Honey" during a phone conversation. Caller indicated it made them very uncomfortable. Reporting Investigator (R/I) contacted caller to get further details on this interaction. (Call recorded and saved in case file.) Caller stated that both employees were arguing on the phone, and other employee attempted to cut caller off by saying "Honey, Honey, Honey." Caller felt it was dismissive and demeaning. Caller said there is no recording of the conversation. R/I informed caller that without evidence the most OPI could do is refer it to the other employee's supervisor and recommend that they be cautioned regarding inappropriate speech. R/I spoke to other employee who claims they did not use the word "Honey" in their conversation, but remembers ending a sentence with the word "Funny."

### FINDINGS:

Unproveable: lack of evidence.
