ALLEGATIONS:

A supervisor was overheard by two fellow employees telling a subordinate, when the supervisor is "on-call" or standby and receives a call for an emergency after hours, if the supervisor opens their computer and calls to clear the job, they put in for overtime as a 4 hour call-in. Policy is to record the minutes it took to clear request if you physically do not leave your home.

FINDINGS:

Unfounded: OPI requested and reviewed all of this employee's overtime pay records for the past 6 months. There were no instances of any 4 hour overtime claims, even on an after hours emergency like the caller described.
