ALLEGATIONS:

Complainant moved into apartment and feels the major code violations are not being addressed by RHA, Monroe County or the City of Rochester. Says the City code enforcement officer has provided a falsified Certificate of Occupancy and falsified documents on 7/29/22 stating apartment is inhabitable. Says Monroe County should not have issued back rent to the landlord due to existing violations.

FINDINGS:

Monroe County relies on a shared City resource to determine if a city property has violations, and the City of Rochester is responsible for the information on that system. The county does not have independent code enforcement officers. Whistleblower information was forwarded to the City of Rochester Office of Public Integrity,
