ALLEGATIONS:

Citizen complained that a county employee was falsifying urinalysis testing, and lied about the complainants admission of drug or alcohol use. Citizen claims to have proof from privately paid urinalysis done contemporary to the "false" positive tests. OPI interviewed complainant and advised that we would review their documentation,.

FINDINGS:

The three private tests the complainant provided were not within the time frame needed to prove that the County's information was incorrect-or a "false positive." Unfounded allegation. As for the allegation regarding a verbal admission, it is unprovable as there is no evidence of the conversation between the complainant and two county employees.
