ALLEGATIONS:

Complainant alleges that a County Employee is using County Computer systems to access complainant's personal and private information. They state that they have previously reported this to the County, but no action was taken.

FINDINGS:

A previous investigation was done, and the allegation was unfounded. Caller was informed of this, but claims that due to the employees ties to NYS Parole, Local Police, and the CIA, no action has been taken. Caller also claimed that employee has attempted to murder them twice, but a local judge refused to issue a protective order for lack of evidence. Caller was invited to provide any evidence in their possession of the employees misdeeds. Caller was advised to contact the FBI or Department of Justice if they wished to report a crime and did not trust local law enforcement to handle the case.
